## Trial Notes:

- 1. The nursery was located approximately 3 miles southeast of Pullman, WA.
- 2. The nursery was fertilized prior to seeding at a rate of 160N, 12P, 17S, 2Zn. No additional fertilizer was applied after soil sampling.
- 3. Yield was 28% lower and test weight was 1.2 lb/bu more compared to 2022.
