#### **James C. Nelson Graduate Fellowships in Transportation Economics**

Amount: Three scholarships ranging from \$3,000 to \$5,000.

#### **Kenneth and Dorothy Casavant Family Excellence Fund Scholarship**

Focus: students interested in pursuing a career in the economics of transportation that includes logistics, freight, transportation mobility, urban transportation, and many other areas.

Amount: One scholarship of \$2,000.

#### **C. Richard and Janet L. Shumway Graduate Fellowship**

Focus: For graduate students interested in resolving economic challenges of high importance to society.

Amount: Three scholarships of \$3,000 each.

#### **Rawlins Award for Excellence in Economics**

Focus: Students interested in ultimately pursuing a doctorate in economics.

Amount: One or two scholarships of \$3,000 to \$6,000 each.

Focus: Students interested in a career in agricultural economics.

Amount: One scholarship of \$2,000.

#### **Robert E. Berney Endowed Fellowship**

Focus: Support high-achieving graduate students interested in macroeconomics, money, and banking.

Amount: One scholarship of \$3,000.

#### **Orlo & Delight Maughan Scholarship**

Focus: Graduate student pursuing a career in agricultural economics.

Amount: One scholarship of \$4,000.
