### Patch or Year Rocker

*The first year the 4-H'er will be awarded the round patch, subsequent years will be awarded the Year Rocker.*

  - Parade
  - Project related event
  - Spring Show
  - Leader Council Fundraiser
- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth must have participated in the Whidbey Island Fair or other fair qualifying shows
- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth must have participated in either an educational display or submitted an education poster
- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth must have held an office and/or been on a committee within their own club
- \_\_\_\_\_ Youth must have had 2/3 participation of their club meetings
