\*Dressage, Western Dressage, Reining & all Yakima County Medal classes must be preentered. No exceptions.

<sup>T</sup>To allow for tack changes, classes preceded with “<sup>T</sup>”, will be preceded by a few trail runs. Arena will be open.

- This show will be operated in accordance with the rules for the 4-H Performance Horse project (<https://wpcdn.web.wsu.edu/wp-extension/uploads/sites/2050/2024/09/Washington-4-H-Equine-Program-Rule-Book.pdf>) In accordance with 4-H rules, all riders must be at least 8 years of age as of October 1, 2024. All riders must wear an approved helmet, when mounted. No stallions of any age allowed. All 4-H classes will be judged according to the Danish System.
- **Class Entries:** Preentries must be postmarked at least one week prior to show. Dressage, Western Dressage, Reining and Medal classes must be preentered. No exceptions. All post entries must be made three classes before the class being entered.
- **Walk-Trot:** Riders must be beginning riders, who have never competed in the show ring at the lope/canter. No cross entry into any canter or loping class, except that riders may enter gaming classes (58-77), according to their age division (ie., Senior, Intermediate, or Junior). Walk-Trot riders **MUST** enter Showmanship according to their age division. **NO GREEN HORSES.**
- **Showmanship:** All riders **MUST** compete in Showmanship, with **EACH** horse entered. Showmanship patterns will be performed one contestant at a time in the arena, to allow a rider to exhibit multiple horses in a class. No penalty will be assessed for sweat marks due to morning classes.
- **Dressage:** Class 1 will consist of individual patterns only. All tests will be ridden in the small (20m x 40m) sized arena. Reader will be allowed. Class placings will be awarded based upon percentage score. May be ridden in choice of dressage seat or hunt seat. The dressage reference will be the *United States Dressage Foundation 2023 Dressage Tests*. Rider must declare level & test. Class **MUST** be preentered.
- **Western Dressage:** Class 8 will consist of individual patterns only. All tests will be ridden in the small (20m x 40m) sized arena. Readers will be allowed. Class placings will be awarded based upon percentage score. Must be ridden western seat. The western dressage reference will be the *Western Dressage Association of America 2022 Western Dressage Tests*. Rider must declare level & test. Class **MUST** be preentered.
- **Disciplined Rail:** Also referred to as “command” or “judge’s choice”. This is an equitation class in which riders perform maneuvers as a group, testing the skills of both the horse and rider, as they execute specific gaits, transitions, and/or movements as requested by the judge. Rider’s choice of seat. All humane bits allowed. Rider’s may ride two-handed.
- **Reining:** The reining pattern and scoresheet can be found at: <https://wpcdn.web.wsu.edu/wp-extension/uploads/sites/2050/2025/03/2025-Reining-State-Fair-Pattern-F.pdf>
- **Trail:** Rider’s choice of seat. Riders may sign-up, upon check-in, to ride trail between morning seat types, to keep the flow of the show moving. Riders may sign-up for periods preceding each class designated by “T”.
- **In Hand Trail:** Horse may not cross enter into any riding class.
- **Medal Classes:** Any Yakima County 4-H exhibitor who has earned 3 blue flats in the specific class, while in their current age classification (Jr, Int, Sr), is qualified to ride for Medals in that class (individual pattern). Please specify which Medal you seek on the entry (Bronze, Silver, Gold #1, Gold #2, or Platinum). Medal patterns are posted on the Yakima County 4-H website, under “4-H Forms”. Medal classes **MUST** be preentered.
- **Multiple Horses:** Rider may enter only one horse in each rail and medal class (if qualified). Rider may enter multiple horses in any pattern class (ie., 1, 8, 12, 18, 20, 22-25, 27-29), as long as each horse is currently registered as that rider’s 4-H horse project & has a valid Horse Certificate. Any rider/horse combo may enter a class only one time (ex., multiple dressage tests may not be ridden on the same horse).
- **Combining Classes:** Classes with less than three exhibitors may be combined, but will be judged separately.
- **Lunch:** Concessions will be available.
