MOVE IN: All birds in cages by 10am on Saturday. Birds will be allowed to move in on Friday at 8am.

SYSTEM OF JUDGING: Danish

ENTRY LIMIT: Exhibitors may enter as many birds as they wish.

All 4-H Department rules apply. Exhibitor must be a member of a 4-H Club. Each exhibitor and parent will receive a wristband and parking pass. Please enter and ALL pay entries online. Youth may cross enter in youth and 4-H. Cages will be provided.

Exhibitors are responsible for the care and feeding of their own animals.

ENTRIES DUE: September 7, 2025

SHOW DATE: Saturday, September 27, 2025 following the Poultry Show

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00

SHOWMANSHIP entries are required to wear long sleeve shirts, pants, and close-toed shoes.

DIVISION:

5027: 4-H Poultry Fitting & Showmanship

CLASS:

01: 4-H Cloverbuds: 5 to 7 years of age

02: 4-H Junior: 8 to 10 years of age

03: 4-H Intermediate: 11 to 13 years of age

04: 4-H Senior: 14 to less than 19 years of age

(Age is determined by October 1st of the current 4-H year (October 1, 2023). Youth who have reached their 5th birthday (before October 1st), through those who have not reached their 19th birthday (before October 1st).

- Order of show will be 4H Seniors, Intermediates and then Juniors.
- Entries are open to any regularly enrolled 4-H or FFA member who is exhibiting at this fair. Entrance in this contest will not bar exhibitor from any other contests in which they are eligible.
- Requirements: each contestant must own the animal they show. Each contestant must fit their own animal and may only be assisted by other regularly enrolled 4H members entered at the fair. NO ADULTS.
- Exhibitors must show that same animal in all phases of showmanship.
- Ratings will be as follows: 50% Fitting and 50% Showing.
