Program	Tuition
WSU Extension Master Gardener volunteer: Intern Training. Payment will be collected via an online payment site following acceptance by your local county.	\$275
WSU Extension Master Gardener volunteer scholarship recipient: Intern training. Payment will be collected via an online payment site following acceptance by your local county and scholarship approval.	\$125
Washington Gardener Certificate: For individuals seeking education with no volunteer requirement. Payment will be collected via online payment site.	\$550
WSU Extension Master Gardener volunteer: For currently certified volunteers who seek continuing education. *	\$125
Current WSU employee (*Employee discount code does not apply to scholarship or current extension master gardener volunteer rate.)	50% discount

WSU Extension Master Gardener and Green School training is equivalent to approximately 4 and 3 credits respectively. For comparison, WSU tuition for in-state resident, undergraduate, 4 credit course is \$1698.00 assuming the individual is a full-time student taking 12-18 credits. Instate tuition for the same credits at an accredited Washington two-year college is \$640.00.
