




*** Rotate Animals Off Pasture When Grass Height Is Down To 3 to 4 Inches!!!!**

- Allows grasses time to recover from grazing, reduces soil compaction and increases forage availability
- Animals taken off pastures at 3 inches and reintroduced at 7 inches
- Plants must have time to recover.....





GRASS GROWING MONTH!



*Mow Pastures After Grazing To Ensure All Plants Are The Same Height And To Prevent Weeds From Going To Seed.



*Do Not Allow Livestock Back On Pasture Until Grass Is 6 – 7 Inches Tall.



*Apply Up To 40% Of Annual Fertilizer Needs.
*Spread Manure And Drag Pastures To Evenly Distribute.
