A proposed six-year (2027-2032) property tax at \$0.21 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation. Jefferson County adopted Resolution 23-0427-26R placing "County Parks & Rec Levy" on the August 4, 2026 ballot. The levy lid lift includes an exemption for qualifying seniors, veterans, and disabled persons under RCW 84.36.381.
