- The *Asotin County Cattlemen* are offering at least one \$500 scholarship to a senior from **either** Asotin or Clarkston High School. Graduates of CHS or AHS who are 1st year college students may also apply.
- The *Asotin County CattleWomen* are offering at least one scholarship in the minimum amount of \$500 to a high school senior attending **either** Clarkston or Asotin High School. Graduates of CHS or AHS who are continuing college students may also apply.

Purpose: The local Asotin County cattle organizations provide these college scholarships to encourage graduating high school seniors and continuing students to pursue a career in an agricultural or family and consumer sciences-related field. Additional fields of study could include but not exclusive to the following areas: Agriculture Business, Agriculture Education, Equine-related fields, John Deere, Industrial Mechanics, Irrigation, Viticulture and Enology, Veterinary, Veterinary Technician, and Welding.

Eligibility: To be considered, a student must be planning to attend a two or four-year college in the fall of 2026; with a major in an area of agriculture or family and consumer sciences. Continuing college students who are applying for scholarships must have graduated from Asotin or Clarkston High Schools and remain a college student in good standing.

Letter(s) of Reference: Please include **two** letters of reference **with** this application from teachers, advisors, employers or other individuals who can accurately speak about your character, activities, and potential to succeed in college.

Scholarship Awards: Recipients must provide proof of college registration before the scholarship monies will be awarded. *The Cattlemen's scholarship* will be awarded for the fall semester. *The CattleWomen's scholarship* will be awarded following the successful completion of your first semester or quarter of college. Additionally, the CattleWomen's scholarship will require proof of registration for the subsequent semester or quarter of college.

Basis for selection will be:

1. Required High School G.P.A. – 3.00 for the CattleWomen's Scholarship, and 2.00 for the Cattlemen's Scholarship (**Please include a copy of your high school transcripts**). **Include college transcripts if attending college.**
2. Application – appearance and completeness.
3. Community service, leadership and participation related to your intended major.
4. Financial need.
