4-H Facilitator Training—Special Offer!

If you would like to receive training on group facilitation, AND be authorized to check out our portable challenge equipment (great for team-building), this is a golden opportunity! We are hosting the three-day class HERE at the Snohomish County Extension building, Sept. 6-8 (Friday-Sunday). Enrolled volunteers and youth age 16 and over (by Sept. 6th) may register at <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10c0d4caca62fa3f85-4hfacilitator>. This is a rare opportunity to get this training at no cost to you! (It's normally a \$250 course.) There is a \$50 commitment deposit that will be refunded upon completion of all three days of the class. Any remaining slots will be open to folks from other counties (for a fee) after July 10th.

Deadlines for Awards

Reminder to nominate and apply for awards by July 1st (most awards) or by the Council meeting on July 10th (Friends of 4-H and Volunteer of the Year).

ALSO, youth who are 4-H seniors and have exhibited at fair at least two years are eligible to apply for the **Outstanding Exhibitor Award!** Applications are due August 1st at the 4-H office. Finalists are interviewed on the second day of the Evergreen State Fair (at the fairgrounds).
