WiFi in the WSU Extension Education Center and Offices

The WiFi options have changed at Extension. If you want to use Wifi at the Everett facility, you have two choices. The less secure option is to use a "WSU Guest" login, which requires getting a password texted to your phone, and cell reception in the building is notoriously weak. If you'd like to use the more secure WSU Wireless connection, you'll need a WSU "friend" account. You can sign up for one here: <https://webapps.wsu.edu/ais/friendaccounts/CreateFriend.aspx> It takes a couple of weeks to get your account, so prepare ahead of time for best results. Once you have an account, you'll be able to connect whenever you're in the buildings, though you'll be prompted to change your password periodically.

The WSU 4-H website has a new statewide page just for 4-H financial information. The last item on the page is a 29-minute training video now required annually for club/program leaders and treasurers.
