Who Must Stay Home

Reminder: People who have been exposed to someone with COVID in the past 14 days and are not fully vaccinated must quarantine. Those who have been diagnosed with COVID must isolate. Those who have symptoms of COVID and don't have a negative test must isolate, regardless of vaccination status.


