Record Books for County-Level Judging Due Oct. 15th

Record books that have earned a blue ribbon (score of 80 or higher) are eligible for county-level judging. RBs other than horse books may be submitted 7:30 – 4:30 on weekdays at Willis Tucker Park. (Tell the front desk person it's for 4-H), OR by appointment at the closed McCollum Park office, OR by appointment with club leaders. Clubs with RBs presented will be asked to provide one adult to help with evaluations.
