If your ballot is not mailed by Tuesday, October 29th, it is recommended that you deposit your ballot into a [ballot drop box](#). Election Day is Tuesday, Nov. 5th. [Accessible voting](#) is available in person, as well. [You can still register](#) in person, until 8 p.m. on the 5th. Civic engagement is a mission mandate of 4-H.
