## GENERAL RULES

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL EXHIBITORS TO KNOW THE SHOW RULES.

ENTRY FEES: - \$3.00 per class or run; CLINIC- \$15.00 per rider

Entries will be accepted the day of the clinic and show, and will be accepted up to one class prior to the class being entered. REFUND OF ENTRY FEES WILL ONLY BE GIVEN ON RECEIPT OF A VETERINARY CERTIFICATION STATING THE NATURE OF THE ANIMAL'S DISABILITY, AND WILL BE MAILED AFTER THE SHOW.

ALL PARTICIPANTS OR GUESTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 (OR THOSE OVER 18 WHO ARE ENROLLED IN 4-H) MUST WEAR PROPERLY FITTED ASTM AND SEI APPROVED HEADGEAR WITH A HARNESS, AS WELL AS APPROPRIATE RIDING BOOTS WHILE MOUNTED ANYWHERE ON THE GROUNDS.

ALL HORSES MUST STAY IN THE INFIELD OR THE DESIGNATED HORSE BARN. HORSES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE LAWNS, NEAR THE FOOD STANDS, IN THE CAMPGROUND, OR IN THE LIVESTOCK BARN OR RACE HORSE BARN OR RACEHORSE BARN AREA. NO RUNNING OF HORSES ON THE GROUNDS OR ON THE RACE TRACK IS ALLOWED.

This is a 4-H sponsored show. All events will be judged in accordance with the 4-H Horse Contest Guide. Refer to that publication regarding equitation, performance, and gaming event rules and requirements. The Judge has the option, and is encouraged to do so, to ask for any reasonable additional work to aid in the placement of any class. The Judge's decision will be final. No person may enter the space set aside for the Judge without permission from the Judge or show management. All entries must be in writing by the horse's owner or agent. Parents or legal guardian must sign all entries of exhibitors under 18 years of age. Competitors must have completed 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and have reached their 8<sup>th</sup> birthday to compete in this show.

Please make requests for gate holds prior to the beginning of a class. No horse will be allowed to enter or exit the ring after the gate is closed without approval of the Judge or show management.

Competitors must appear in the ring with suitable tack and attire, and their number clearly visible to the judge. Entries without a number may be disqualified. Numbers on a saddle pad must be visible on both sides of the horse.

Stallions may only be shown by adults (18 years of age or older) and must be under control at all times. Camping is available in the infield or in the campground at current campground rates, payable to the Ferry County Fairgrounds.

Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry of any competitor who has shown an objectionable attitude toward a given show, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a show or to show management. Show management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or split classes, and to substitute or vary officials. Competitors will be advised of any changes. The North Ferry 4-H Club, the members, the show committee and associates will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury from any cause that may occur to any person, horse, or any article of any kind that may be occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by them or arise from the negligence of any person in charge of any horse. All horses are exhibited entirely at the owner's risk.
