SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Whitman County Crop Improvement Association is offering one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to a graduating high school senior who is continuing their education at a two or four year college, university, trade or technical school in an Agriculture related field.

The scholarship is limited to students whose home residence is in Whitman County and is a graduating high school senior (or home-school equivalent). The student **must** be continuing their course of study and/or training in an Agriculture related field.

Guidelines For Application

The applicant **must** supply the Whitman County Crop Improvement Association with **all** of the following information:

- 1. A typed, completed and signed application form and a photo.**
- 2. A one-page double spaced essay describing the applicant's goals and plans in their chosen Ag related field AND include a personal experience that influenced this decision.**
- 3. A copy of their current high school transcript with a cumulative grade point average.**
- 4. A letter of recommendation from a person who is employed in Agriculture or from a member of Whitman County Crop Improvement Association.**
- 5. Please limit your responses to the space provided.**
- 6. Applications must be received no later than May 1.**
