Youth Rotating Flock Application

Terms of Use:

1. Recipient receives loan of five ewes for use in 4-H, FFA or individual breeding projects for the period of one year (September—September)
2. Recipient will be responsible for insurance coverage of ewes.
3. Recipient is responsible for care of ewe string and lambs for one year. This includes breeding ewes in the fall.
4. Recipient is entitled to ownership of the oldest ewe and all offspring except one quality replacement ewe lamb which shall be returned with the flock.
5. Recipient will be determined according to their potential for growth and development in a 4-H, FFA, or individual sheep breeding project.
