SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Whitman County Cattlemen's Association, each year, offers one or more scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are continuing their education at a two or four year college, university, trade or technical school in an Agriculture related field.

Scholarship Requirements:

- The scholarship is limited to students whose home residence is in Whitman County and is a graduating high school senior (or home-school equivalent).
- The student **must** be continuing their course of study and/or training in an Agriculture related field.
- The applicant **must** supply the Whitman County Cattlemen's Association with **all** of the following information:

- 1. A typed, completed and signed application form.**
- 2. A one-page essay describing the applicant's goals and plans in their chosen Ag related field AND include a personal experience that influenced this decision.**
- 3. A copy of their current high school transcript with a cumulative grade point average.**
- 4. A letter of recommendation from a Current Member of the Whitman County Cattlemen's Association. Members may only write one recommendation letter per year. (Current member information may be obtained by calling Kim Weerts at 509-288-1042.) (Letters from professionals, university employees, club adviser, etc. will not be accepted.)**
