4H Classes count for State qualification for Intermediates and Seniors.*

**Open Divisions:** ❖ Walk/Jog(Trot): all ages ❖ Adult: over 18 ❖ Youth: ages 8-18  
*(Open Youth is only for youth not eligible for 4H horse show classes or who are not 4H members)*

*4H horse competitor for Fair 2026 MUST show in 4H classes (not Open) at this show.*

*No cross entry between: Open & 4H, Age Division classes, Riding & In Hand, Maiden classes, and Walk/Jog classes*

*You may only enter 4H Walk/(Trot)Jog your first and second year before showing in lope classes.*

*Maidens are never to have won a blue ribbon in that event.*

**Walk/Trot(Jog) and Maiden divisions not eligible to qualify for State Fair.**

*Horses cannot be shared between Open and 4H exhibitors. Horses cannot be shared between exhibitors in the same division (i.e. two 4H exhibitors in the Junior division) but can be shared in two different 4H divisions (i.e. one exhibitor in 4H Walk/Trot Intermediate and one in 4H Seniors)*

*Classes may be combined as needed, if possible, but will be announced and posted during the show*

4H rules for classes apply...including helmets required for 18 and under. Judged by the Danish system.

4H Participants must be currently enrolled 4H or FFA members.

**All youth 18 and under must have a designated adult chaperone present, including overnight.**

**Clallam County Fairgrounds Camping Rules & Regulations**

1. There must be an adult staying in each campsite.
2. Use or possession of intoxicants, narcotics, illegal drugs, or use of vulgarity is prohibited on the grounds and camping area. Any campers using loud or profane language will be dismissed from the Fairgrounds. General Rules of the Fair apply.
3. Enforced quiet hours are from 10pm-8am. Generators must be turned off during quiet hours. Please advise everyone in the campsite of the quiet hour requirements.
4. No campfires are allowed on the Fairgrounds.
5. All pets must remain on a leash.
6. Please remember to clean up your campsite area and stalls before you leave.
