_____ Complete a 4-H Record Book (WSU Publication C0934), or the 4-H Market Livestock Record packet, (available at <https://extension.wsu.edu/graysharbor/4-h/links/>), or a similar recordkeeping resource.

_____ Attend a 4-H Record Book Check-in session with WSU Extension staff and submit this Expectation Form (Several summer dates will be scheduled for you to register in advance)
