British Columbia has implemented a revenue-neutral carbon tax that many economists and environmentalist consider to be the most effective form of climate policy. In Washington, CarbonWA.org is leading an effort to promote a BC-style tax swap that will reduce taxes and fund the Working Families Sales Tax Rebate.

Yoram Bauman is an environmental economist based in Seattle and a fellow at the Sightline Institute, a non-profit research center focused on Northwest sustainability. He co-authored *Tax Shift* (1998) which helped to inspire the revenue-neutral carbon tax in British Columbia.
