Biography of Artist

Garrett Snedeker is a pianist and music teacher in the Wenatchee Valley. In 2019 he was the recipient of the Trinity Laban Postgraduate Award by the US-UK Fulbright Commission, for which he completed his Master of Music degree in Piano Performance at Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance in London, England. In 2020, Garrett was a recipient of the Barzun Prize for Youth Engagement to found *Intersections*, a community music program which partners Trinity Laban Conservatoire students with charities in Southeast London serving marginalized youth to compose, play, and perform music.

Snedeker received his Bachelor of Music in Piano Performance/Pedagogy from Washington State University, where he was recognized as a 2019 Outstanding Senior and Top Ten Senior in the Performing Arts. Garrett studied piano with Douglas Finch and Peter Tuite at Trinity Laban Conservatoire, and Dr. Jeff Savage at WSU.

Garrett is currently Music Specialist at Lewis and Clark Elementary in Wenatchee, WA, and Adjunct Piano Faculty at Wenatchee Valley College. He loves to play piano, hike, watch birds, and paint outdoors with his amazing wife Natalie.
