- Narrative essay by nominator that describes some of the impacts created because of the nominee's participation as a volunteer in the 4-H Youth Development Program. (Limited to 3 pages with 1-inch margins, no smaller than 12-point font).
- Letters of recommendation (3).
- If selected, a digital photograph (600 dpi or greater) will be requested no later than September 15.

On a separate sheet of paper, please provide a typed narrative essay that describes some of the nominee's 4-H activities. Please discuss:

- Nominee's positive impact on 4-H youth
- Explain any new programs, events and/or fundraising initiatives nominee created.
- This statement should be no longer than 3 pages in 12-point font with 1-inch margins.

Letters of Recommendation Guidelines

Please submit three (3) letters of recommendation for the nominee. The letters of recommendation should be written by a 4-H staff member, 4-H youth participant, another volunteer, or a parent/guardian, and address the following items:

- Work ethic and dedication to 4-H
- Demonstrated ability to work with young people
- Recruitment of additional 4-H volunteers
- Advocacy of the 4-H youth development movement
- Dedicated to youth empowerment or youth/adult partnerships
- Professional attitude, character, and morals
