Outstanding County Teen Leader Pin and Certificate Guidelines

1. Outstanding volunteers from each county will be recognized during the Annual State 4-H Recognition Event. The State 4-H Youth Development Program will present pins and certificates to one teen per county.
2. If your county policy is to select more than one teen, your county will be responsible for the additional pin cost of \$10.00 per person (the state pays for 1).
3. If the teen is not present at the recognition ceremony, an alternate individual may pick up the pin and certificate for that person.
