## Outstanding County Volunteer Pin and Certificate Guidelines

1. Outstanding volunteers from each county will be recognized during the Annual State 4-H Recognition Event. The State 4-H Youth Development Program will present pins and certificates to one honored volunteer or couple per county.
2. If your county policy is to select more than one volunteer, your county will be responsible for the additional pin cost of \$10.00 per person (the state pays for 1).
3. If the volunteer is not present at the recognition ceremony, an alternate individual may pick up the pin and certificate for that person; or the award can be mailed to the County Office.
