**Nomination must include:**

- This cover sheet with nominee and nominator's name and contact information.
- Narrative essay by nominator that includes:
  - Nominee's position title and brief job description;
  - Description of how the nominee's work impacted 4-H beyond their job responsibility;
  - Describe the nominee's relationship with volunteers;
  - Explain how their work has impacted the nominator(s) life or business
  - Explain how their work has impacted the community.
  - (Limited to 3 pages with 1-inch margins, no smaller than 12-point font).
- If selected, a digital photograph (600 dpi or greater) will be requested no later than September 15.
