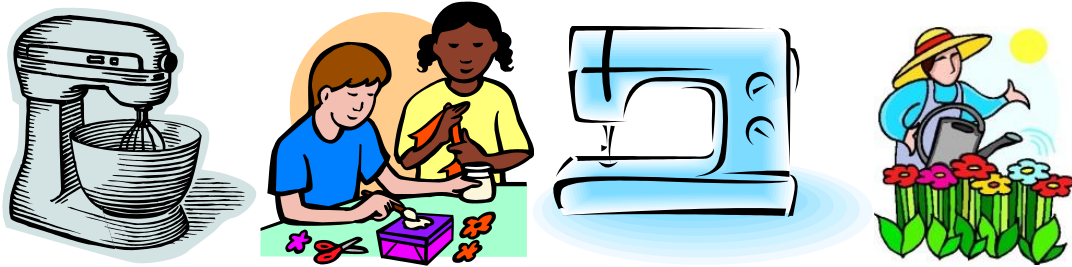


**Klickitat County 4-H Still Life Camp
