## Poultry & Pigeon Showmanship

Since judging and showmanship are conflicting with one another, it might not work to use a bird in both competitions. To eliminate that problem, do not enter your showmanship bird into the judging class. The class will not stop to wait for you. We have such a limited time bracket to do our judging. We would appreciate it if you would keep this in mind when you fill out your entry form.

Showmanship will be placed into classes as follows:

Seniors - Grades 9,10,11,12

Intermediates - Grades 6,7,8

Juniors - Grades 3,4,5

Novice - Grades 1,2 and youth that have never participated in showmanship before.

***Recommended attire for fitting and showing is:*** Black pants or skirt and an all white long sleeve collared shirt. However, our barn can be very cold, please feel free to wear a jacket if necessary.

**There is no need to send an entry for those who are just doing Showmanship. There is no fee for showmanship.**

1. Entry fee must accompany entry form.
2. The entry fee is \$2.00 per bird, \$4.00 double coops
3. This is a youth show. You must be 18 years old or younger to exhibit your birds and be present to win awards.
4. Chickens, Ducks, Geese, Turkeys and Pigeons (no doves or quail)
5. Each entry must be entered in one of the following sex/age categories:  
C - Cock, Old Tom, Old Cock, Old Drake/Gander - male over one year of age.  
H - Hen, Old Hen, Old Duck/Goose - female over one year of age  
K - Cockerel, Young Tom, Young Cock, Young Drake/Gander - male under one year old.  
P - Pullet, Young Hen, Young Duck/Goose- Female under one year of age.
6. Birds need to be in place by 9:00 am.
7. Owners are responsible for feeding and watering their own birds. Both food and water will be provided.
8. Judges decisions are final!
