Use this at home or with your 4-H Club virtually for a two week period of time. Use our directions and supplementary slides to facilitate distance learning challenges.

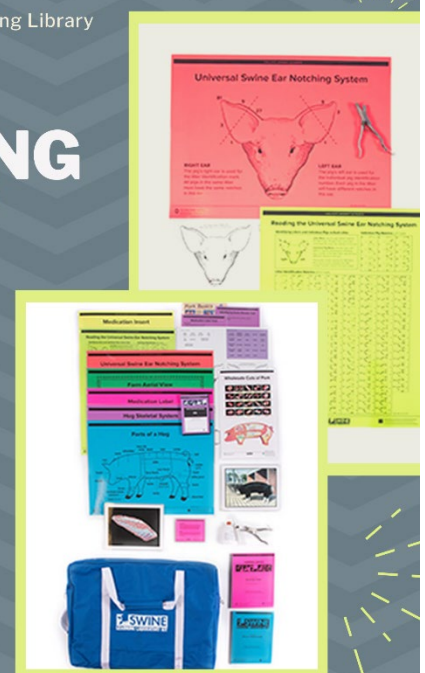

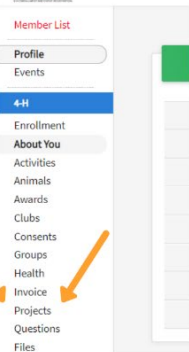
ADDING PROJECTS IN 4H ONLINE For Approved 4-H Members

Log into your family account.

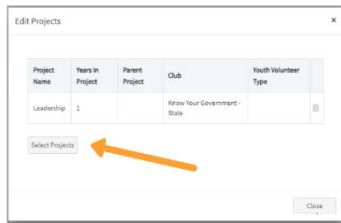
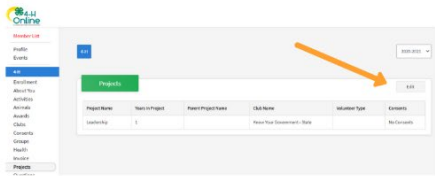
1) Select "View" on the member you want to edit
