2. If the teen leader is not present at the recognition ceremony, an alternate individual may pick up the pin and certificate for that person; or the award can be mailed to the County Office.
3. Posters/displays for Outstanding County Teen Leader should be made by each county and exhibited at the recognition event.
4. Please submit a picture (600 DPI or higher, if possible) of your outstanding volunteer electronically. **A photograph is required no later than October 10)**
