Wahkiakum 4-H Youth Program offers a 3-Day beginning sewing class, teaching basic sewing techniques and how to use and care for a sewing machine. Class will be offered July 14-116, 9 am to 11:15 am for young sewers, and 9 am to 12:15 for older or more advanced sewers.

Each participant in Sewing For Fun will make a few items, learn basic straight stitching, hand sewing, using a simple pattern, and details about basic sewing supplies and equipment. Projects include a pincushion, needle holder, apron and additional projects if time allows.

Sewing machines are available, and students may also bring their own sewing machine in good working condition. Bring the machine instruction book if available.

Basic sewing supplies and a notebook for the beginning class are included in the registration fee. Students and parents/adults will be advised at the Orientation Session on what fabric to buy for the best results with the class projects.

WHEN & WHERE:

The 4-H Youth Summer Sewing School will be held at **Johnson Park, 30 Rosburg School Road, Rosburg, WA; 9 am to 11:15 am for young sewers; 9 am to 12:15 pm for older and more advanced sewers.**

SEWING SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS:

1. The class is for youth who have completed 3rd grade through 12th grade.
2. Each student may provide their own sewing machine in good working order and machine instruction book. Machines will also be available in the class.
3. Students may bring their own fabric of their choice. If they don't have their own fabric, some will be available of limited variety.
4. Students must have their own transportation to and from Johnson Park.
5. Students should be well rested and be eager to sew.
6. **A required parent/guardian Orientation Session** is

scheduled for 6:30 pm, July 1st, at the River Street Meeting Room, 25 River St, in Cathlamet and via Zoom. A parent or designated adult representative is required to attend the orientation for the student to participate in Sewing School. If no adult representative attends the orientation, the youth will not be able to participate in sewing school and their registration money will be refunded.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

1. Class size is limited. Students are registered on a **first paid, first served basis**. **Registration Deadline is Wednesday, July 9th, 2025.**
2. Mail the completed registration form and cash/check payable to Wahkiakum 4-H Leaders Council and mail to PO Box 278, Cathlamet, WA 98612 **or** drop off at the WSU Extension Office, 25 River Street Ste. E, Cathlamet; Monday-Wednesday between 9:00 a.m. - 3 p.m.
3. The **registration fee** for Sewing for Fun 1 students this year is **\$35, additional sibling(s) \$25 each** and includes a kit of basic sewing notions and a notebook. If this is your second year and you have your sewing kit from last year, the fee is \$25.
