CLALLAM COUNTY 4-H LEADERS COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM
“REQUIREMENTS”
(THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE WILL DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY)

The Clallam County 4-H Leaders Council Scholarship program is funded through a countywide effort of our 4-H Leaders Council to support secondary education for our local 4-H members. All 4-H members have the opportunity to receive the 4-H Leader's Council scholarship if they meet the following criteria:

1. 4-H members are automatically part of the Clallam County 4-H Leaders Council Scholarship program when they reach 8th grade or when they join Clallam County 4-H after their 8th grade year.
2. To qualify for a Senior Scholarship, members must have been enrolled in Clallam County 4-H and have at least COMPLETED their 4-H year in 11th and 12th grade.
3. To qualify for scholarship “credit” each year from 8th-12th grade (up to 5 years), participating members MUST assist with the annual Scholarship Fundraisers. This can include helping in many areas of fundraising. Ask your club leader for ways to participate.
4. When 4-H members reach their Senior year, members must complete the following application process:
 - **By April 1st:** 4-H members must turn in their UP TO DATE AND COMPLETE 4-H record book with application page in the front of the book to the Extension Office or Forks representative. ALL sections must be up to date including EACH leader's signature for ALL projects, complete list of ALL projects, 4-H Story must be started, and Permanent record must be in record book.
 - **By August 1st:** 4-H members must have completed a club level demonstration, attended 2/3rds of general club meetings, and turn in your Record Book to club leader for fair deadline review.
 - **By October 1st:** Members completed 4-H record book must be turned in with completed application page in front of book to the Extension Office.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. The amount of the scholarship is \$200 per 4-H year completed from 8-12th grade, up to \$1000. (Subject to adequate fundraising each year.)
2. If member is unsure as to which school they will be attending when application is filled out for the April 1st deadline, mark undecided. Notify Extension Office 360-417-2398 when school is decided.
3. Scholarship funds are mailed directly to the school that 4-H member designates. Funds are not mailed to a member or family members. 4-H member will need to give complete name of school, address and your student ID number to receive your scholarship. Any deviation from this must be approved by 4-H Leaders Council.
4. Recipients will receive a letter or notification that the 4-H Leaders Council Scholarship has been dispersed.
5. The Scholarship needs to be used within 2(two) years of graduation from high school or High School Equivalency.
6. Scholarship may be used anywhere in the U.S. at any accredited, online advanced schooling classes or trade school or continuing educational institutions.
