ENROLLMENT INFORMATION



To all our valued members and volunteers, welcome to a new year in Pacific County 4-H!

The new 4-H year officially began on October 1st using a new version of 4HOnline for the enrollment process. We hear that the new system is a bit more user friendly and easier to navigate. Yay!

All new and returning 4-H youth members and adult volunteers must enroll in the 4-H Youth Development Program by logging in to their profile and entering information in the 4-H Online enrollment database system at <https://v2.4honline.com/>

If you were enrolled in 4-H prior to the 2020-2021 4-H year, you're in luck! Your enrollment information has been transferred into the new version of 4HOnline! To log into 4HOnline to reenroll, you'll need your previous login credentials (email and password). If you do not know what email address you used in the original 4HOnline, please contact the Extension Office for assistance. DO NOT create a new family! If you do not remember your password, you can use the "Forgot Password" option on the login screen.

Remember that all enrollment fees are generously paid for by the Pacific County 4-H Leaders Council.

WINTER GARDEN MATCHING GAME

You don't have to be enrolled in the garden project to play this game! We are familiar with most of these plants in the growing season, but can you identify them in winter? Look closely at the beautiful leaf colors and shapes, seed pods, etc. and see how winter changes what we see in the garden.

WINTER MATCHING GAME

We are familiar with our plants during the growing season, but can we identify these plants or plant parts in winter, as shown in the photos below? Give it a try with these 6 common garden plants that grow in our climate. Some are easy and some are not. The answers are given in the box at the bottom of this page.

What you know or do not know is not the point. What is amazing about each of these pictures is how beautifully the season accentuates the features of each plant; the shape of the leaf or seed pods, the color, the venation, the hairiness. Winter gives us a chance to know our plants with new eyes. A common leaf or seed pod becomes gorgeous when outlined in frost.


