HANDS-ON INSTRUCTION

- Teens will work in small groups of 4-5 individuals to create short (2-6 min) films that touch on an aspect of mental health, suicide prevention, substance use prevention, or similar topic that is important to them.

CREATIVE FREEDOM

- We hope that our young future filmmakers will bring their own creativity and passion to the drawing board. Experts will be there to consult, but creative freedom will be respected wherever possible.

EXPERT GUIDANCE

- Each teen group will have access to a content-expert (mental health, suicide prevention, and substance use) to help guide them in ensuring accurate information is shared. In addition to content experts, guidelines will be provided to ensure the films are appropriate for young people to view.

TEEN RECOGNITION

- The films created will be shared far and wide, with credits to the teen filmmakers.

SPACE IS LIMITED TO 20 TEENS!

Open to Senior 4-H members. Applications accepted May 1 - 15, 2024 with special consideration given to teens accessing state-level 4-H opportunities for the first time. Applicants will be notified by May 31, 2024.

\$100 registration covers all fees except transportation to and from camp and is due July 1, 2024. *Teens are responsible for their own travel arrangements.*

Scholarships available to offset or cover registration.

Consider what kind of things you and your family would learn about culture, family, friendship, and hospitality by welcoming someone into your home.

You may be eligible to host one of the amazing student delegates who are coming to the US this year through 4-H! These students have been through an extensive application process testing their English skills, their motivation for wanting to study in the US, and their willingness to share their culture and give back to their host community through volunteerism.

The program runs for 10 months, from August 2024 through June 2025.
