

4-H CLUB AGREEMENT

At the beginning of each year, leaders, members, and parents should agree on expectations for member participation in the club.

The following County requirements must be met by members of all clubs:

- Comply with the 4-H Youth Member Code of Conduct (as agreed to in 4-H Online)
- Enroll in at least 1 project
- Attend 70% of club meetings
- Keep a record book
- Present a demonstration to your club
- Do a community service project with your club

Clubs may consider including the following:

- Project meeting attendance
- Serve as a committee member or club officer
- Present a demonstration at a County Demo Day, fair, or other event.
- Exhibit at a fair
- Enter a judging or showing contest
- Participate in leadership activities
- Participate in an out-of-club activity such as camp or conference
