INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT, AMENDMENT 8

Between

THE STATE OF WASHINGTON

Auditor's Office

AND

WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY – EXTENSION ENERGY PROGRAM

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between the Washington State Auditor's Office, hereinafter referred to as "SAO", and the Washington State University by and through its Extension Energy Program, hereinafter referred to as "University".

IT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS AMENDMENT to extend the period of performance, to modify the hourly rate and staff and total consideration governing the Washington State University – Extension Energy Program's provision of subject matter expertise to SAO during the fieldwork for the Energy Independence Act Compliance Examination project ("Project"). SAO is required by state law (RCW 19.285.070) to audit qualifying consumer-owned utility compliance with the Energy Independence Act.

1. STATEMENT OF WORK

The scope of work remains unchanged from the original agreement dated February 22, 2012. The amendment extends the duration of the agreement and agrees to update billing rates (see table below).

2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

Subject to its other provisions, the period of performance of this agreement shall begin **May 1, 2021**, and be completed on **June 30, 2023** unless terminated sooner as provided herein.

The parties may extend this Agreement through an amendment agreed to and signed by both Parties in order for the University to continue to provide subject matter expertise for additional phases of the Project.

3. CONSIDERATION

Compensation for the work provided in accordance with this Agreement has been established under the terms of RCW 39.34.130. Compensation for each work statement will be established in each Task Order. The Parties have determined that the cost of accomplishing the work issued under the agreement (including the original agreement and this amendment) will not exceed \$410,000 in total. Billing rates will be in accordance with the table below.
