

**FACULTY-LED PROGRAM AGREEMENT**  
**SWISS STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM**  
**BETWEEN**  
**WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY**  
**AND**  
**U.C. CESAR RITZ AG IN SWITZERLAND**

**THIS AGREEMENT** (the "AGREEMENT") is made and entered into by and between **WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY** (hereinafter referred to as "WSU") and **U.C. CESAR RITZ AG** (hereinafter referred to as "CESAR RITZ").

**WHEREAS**, the parties have previously executed that certain Study Abroad Program Agreement (WSU Contract #15267) (the "PREVIOUS AGREEMENT"), which set forth the general terms and conditions governing the collaborative study abroad program between WSU and CESAR RITZ; and

**WHEREAS**, by execution of this AGREEMENT, the parties intend to terminate the PREVIOUS AGREEMENT, and replace it with this AGREEMENT.

**I. TERMINATION OF PREVIOUS AGREEMENT**

The parties hereby terminate in full the PREVIOUS AGREEMENT, and agree that they shall have no further rights or obligations thereunder.

**II. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this AGREEMENT is to outline the parameters of study abroad program for WSU undergraduate students between WSU and CESAR RITZ, to be offered at the University Center Cesar Ritz (UCCR) campus located in Brig, Switzerland. The program reciprocally allows WSU undergraduate students and CESAR RITZ undergraduate Bachelor in International Business (BIB) students to take courses taught by WSU faculty member(s) and/or CESAR RITZ faculty, with the ultimate goal of generally equivalent numbers of students taking courses from the two institutions.

**III. TERM**

This AGREEMENT shall be effective on the first day of the WSU Fall 2012 semester (August 20, 2012). It shall continue in force as stated for a seven (7)

year period, at which time it may be extended by mutual agreement of both parties.

#### IV. TERMS FOR WSU SWISS STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

- A. The WSU Swiss Study Abroad Program will be offered during UCCR's 11-week Fall and Winter terms (hereinafter referred to as Fall and Spring semesters, respectively) at the UCCR campus in Brig, Switzerland. Contact hours per credit will match the 15-week expectation of WSU home campus. Normally the fall term will commence around the first of October and the winter term will start the second Monday of January, depending upon the CESAR RITZ academic calendar.
- B. Target size for the WSU program will be 25 WSU students per semester. A list of WSU student participants and registration information for each student (name, home address, date of birth and nationality) for UCCR registration purposes is to be provided by WSU to UCCR 60 days prior to the start of the respective term.
- C. WSU students will be required to take a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester of upper-division business coursework (i.e., 300 or 400 level classes) and other coursework per student needs (e.g., foreign languages).
- D. Courses offered during a typical semester will include 6 credits taught by WSU faculty and 6 credits taken among appropriate, existing UCCR courses. WSU will provide at least 6 upper division credit hours per semester to all WSU students via on-site WSU-associated faculty member(s). Whenever possible, WSU faculty will spend the entire semester at the UCCR campus. WSU courses may serve as core or elective requirements for the Bachelors and/or Master's programs offered by CESAR RITZ. WSU course offerings will be coordinated with the UCCR program director. An additional 3 credit hours of coursework may be provided by a second on-site WSU faculty member (most likely in an abbreviated time frame) depending upon program size and staffing availability. CESAR RITZ will make available at least 6 upper division transferable business or other courses from its course offerings relevant to the WSU degree per term to all WSU students free of charge. Maximum normal class size for any course taught by WSU faculty member(s) is 60 students.
- E. Courses for which WSU are responsible generally will not exceed 60 students (composed of up to 30 WSU and 30 UCCR students respectively). Each party will attempt to provide equal numbers of students participating in the courses. If the number of UCCR students participating in WSU-taught courses brings enrollments to greater than 60, CESAR RITZ will provide additional support services (e.g., TA assistance) as negotiated with the WSU program director and respective WSU faculty member(s). In such instances, notification of class sizes

must be provided to WSU by CESAR RITZ no later than 60 days prior to the beginning of the term.

- F. WSU students will receive 11 weeks of room and board (including lunch and dinner Monday thru Friday) for a mutually agreed upon fee that will be negotiated by both parties and administered by CESAR RITZ administration. Room accommodations will be for no more than 2 students per room of standard quality as offered in Brig. WSU students may check into their accommodations four days before the beginning of the term and must leave two days after end of term. Students will be responsible for any damages to their accommodations.
- G. For each student, WSU will pay for an 11-week semester to CESAR RITZ \$5,040 US dollars 30-days prior to the beginning of the term. This amount includes: lunch and dinner Monday through Friday during the term; double room occupancy in standard accommodations; UCCR course materials; library use; wireless internet access; local tourism taxes; emergency assistance; college events; and other educational related expenses. If there is a great fluctuation in exchange rates, each party agrees to a new negotiated fee schedule.
- H. In the event that payment to CESAR RITZ will be delayed beyond the above dates due to the failure of the student(s) to pay the WSU Education Abroad Office, or due to the inability of the parties to fully execute the agreement by the due dates, or for any other legitimate reason on which the parties may concur, the parties may agree in writing (and e-mail communications will be sufficient) to extend the due date for payment to a future date upon which the parties may agree. Any such written communication agreeing to extend the due dates shall be appended to this agreement and become a part hereof.
- I. WSU students are responsible for textbooks; health and accident insurance; all lunches; all meals on weekends and school holidays; any travel costs; and personal expenses.
- J. CESAR RITZ will require WSU students to have insurance. WSU will ensure that all WSU student participants are covered by a student accident and sickness insurance policy that covers participants outside the U.S. for the duration of the program and includes 24-hour emergency assistance service, medical evacuation, and repatriation of remains. Swiss authorities will not require any other insurance for periods of up to 3 months. No visa or student permits will be required for US and Canadian citizen for the 11 weeks program, since they will be considered 'tourists.' Students requiring a visa for Switzerland will be required to pay visa fees and for insurance. The cost of the insurance coverage to these students is approximately CHF 500 for the term. WSU will inform CESAR RITZ of any participants who may need a student visa for Switzerland.
- K. Students staying in Europe after the program end will be responsible for any additional housing arrangements and costs. CESAR RITZ will provide storage

space free of charge immediately before and after the semester for WSU students while they travel. CESAR RITZ assumes no liability for any loss of or damage to any stored items.

V. GENERAL TERMS

- A. Neither institution will be expected to take any action which would be contrary to its established academic regulations and practice.
- B. All WSU/BRIG study abroad participants must meet the requirements established for students and staff by CESAR RITZ and host country law. These may include, but are not limited to, health insurances, visas, and work permits.
- C. The economic viability of the exchange program for WSU is contingent upon continued budgetary support by WSU central administration.
- D. By June 15<sup>th</sup>, both parties will agree on courses (and associated prerequisites) to be offered during the Fall and Spring semesters of the upcoming academic year.
- E. Transcripts for UCCR students will be issued by CESAR RITZ. Transcripts for ICHA courses for WSU students will be issued by CESAR RITZ, and transcripts for WSU students for WSU courses will be issued by WSU. Prior to the beginning of a particular semester, WSU (in consultation with CB Professional Advisors) will ensure that UCCR course credits will be accepted by WSU and CESAR RITZ will ensure that the WSU courses taken by UCCR students will count towards the BIB graduation requirements.
- F. WSU assumes no financial or other liability for the operation of UCCR or any other liability incurred by CESAR RITZ.

VI. DUTIES OF WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

- A. WSU will provide a faculty program director who oversees and administers the program, promotes the program to WSU students and staff, visits the UCCR campus at least once per year, and serves as liaison with WSU and CESAR RITZ administration.
- B. WSU will assist CESAR RITZ with the promotion of the WSU study abroad program including providing materials for CESAR RITZ promotional materials.
- C. WSU will assure that the academic coursework it is responsible for at CESAR RITZ will be taught at the highest academic levels by AACSB qualified faculty members at WSU.

- D. WSU will use best efforts to assure that the number of WSU students per semester is as equivalent as possible between the Fall and Spring semesters of a particular academic year. The exact number of students per semesters will be provided to CESAR RITZ at least 60 days before the first day of the program.
- E. WSU will work with UCCR personnel in making accommodation arrangements for WSU instructional faculty member(s). Assistance in finding accommodations will be provided by UCCR personnel in Brig.
- F. WSU will coordinate all academic matters through David Sprott, Faculty Director, Associate Dean, WSU College of Business, or his successor or designee. WSU will coordinate all contractual obligations through Candace Chenoweth, Director, WSU Education Abroad, or her successor or designee.

#### **VII. DUTIES OF CESAR RITZ**

- A. CESAR RITZ will provide fully equipped and appropriately sized classroom(s) for all WSU courses taught at the UCCR campus.
- B. CESAR RITZ will provide assistance to WSU faculty member(s) during their procurement of necessary work permits and visas as required by Switzerland. Faculty are responsible for related fees and other charges.
- C. CESAR RITZ will provide one fully-equipped office (including computer and phone) for the WSU faculty member(s). Costs for phone calls and supplies are covered by WSU. In addition, WSU faculty member(s) will be provided with access to library resources and computer network.
- D. CESAR RITZ will provide to WSU faculty member(s) administrative support related to their professional activities at UCCR. Fees will be charged for private and personal services at cost.
- E. CESAR RITZ will provide WSU faculty member(s) with full meal plan free of charge. The faculty member(s) can purchase meals for visiting guests and family members at an additional rate.
- F. CESAR RITZ will invite WSU on-site faculty member(s) to teach an additional course for CESAR RITZ based on course demand and faculty expertise at a fee to be agreed upon between the faculty member and UCCR.

#### **VIII. REFUNDS**

Refunds: The refund policy will be as stated below.

- A. If a student withdraws from the program prior to 60 days before the start of the semester, WSU and CESAR RITZ will make every effort to provide a refund of all *uncommitted* funds; however there should be no expectation of a refund.
- B. If a student is forced to withdraw from the program for personal, documented medical reasons within the 60 days before the program start, WSU and CESAR RITZ will make every effort to provide a full refund of uncommitted funds, less a 25% processing fee, however there should be no expectation of a refund.
- C. If, within the 60 days before the program start, a student is forced to withdraw from the program for any non-medical reason, WSU and CESAR RITZ will not provide any refund to the student and full fees will be paid to CESAR RITZ.
- D. In the event that a student is dismissed from the program for any violation of either WSU or CESAR RITZ's student conduct codes, WSU and CESAR RITZ will not provide any refund to the student.
- E. In the event that WSU should be forced to cancel the program prior to 120 days before the start of the semester, WSU is under no fee obligation to CESAR RITZ.
- E. Charges for the students' dorm rooms are generally considered committed funds and there should be no expectation of a refund.

#### **IX. CRISIS MANAGEMENT**

- A. If, prior to the start of an academic term, the U.S. State Department issues a travel warning advising U.S. citizens to refrain from travel to, Brig, Switzerland, CESAR RITZ and WSU would work together to relocate the program, if possible, or to reschedule the program. If alternative arrangements cannot be made, and the program is cancelled, WSU and CESAR RITZ would work together to refund all fees paid to the extent possible.
- B. If, after the academic term has begun, the U.S. State Department issues a travel warning advising U.S. citizens to leave Brig, Switzerland, CESAR RITZ will assist WSU in every way possible in the safe and timely evacuation of the WSU faculty and students. In this event, CESAR RITZ will make every effort to maintain twice-daily contact with the WSU Education Abroad Office to report on the health and safety of the WSU participants.
- C. If participants were evacuated as described in section B. above, CESAR RITZ would provide a pro-rata rebate of any *uncommitted* program fees, less a 25% processing fee and any costs incurred to evacuate the participants. All participants would be responsible for their own return flight costs.
- D. If the event of suspension of the program and participant evacuation, participants not wishing to return to their home will be required to sign a release of liability assuming full responsibility for their decision not to comply with WSU and CESAR RITZ's recommendation to evacuate and U.S. State Department Travel Warnings.

## **X. PROBLEM RESOLUTION**

- A. CESAR RITZ and the WSU faculty director(s) agree to meet as frequently as deemed necessary by either party to discuss the program including academics, housing, excursions, and so on.
- B. CESAR RITZ agrees to notify the WSU Faculty Director of any complaint(s) it receives relating to academic issues or to student health, safety, general welfare, or conduct within 24 hours of receiving such the complaint.
- C. WSU agrees to notify CESAR RITZ of any complaint(s) it receives relating to academic issues or to student health, safety, general welfare, or conduct within 24 hours of receiving such the complaint.
- D. The WSU Faculty Director agrees to e-mail a report summarizing *significant* action taken relating to academic issues or to student health, safety, general welfare, or conduct issues to the WSU Education Abroad Office within 24 hours of the director being notified.
- E. In the case of a medical emergency, CESAR RITZ immediately will provide all appropriate assistance. The WSU faculty director will notify the WSU Education Abroad Office of any such situation as soon as possible, but in no event later than twenty-four (24) hours after any given incident.
- F. WSU Faculty Director will solicit a brief, written evaluation of the program from CESAR RITZ and forward to the WSU Education Abroad Office no later than thirty days after program end.

## **XI. DISCRIMINATION AND SEXUAL HARRASSMENT**

- A. CESAR RITZ agrees to abide with WSU policies pertaining to discrimination and sexual harassment as published on the WSU web site at: [http://www.wsu.edu/~forms/HTML/EPM/EP15\\_Discrimination\\_and\\_Sexual\\_Harassment.htm](http://www.wsu.edu/~forms/HTML/EPM/EP15_Discrimination_and_Sexual_Harassment.htm)
- B. WSU agrees to abide with CESAR RITZ policies pertaining to discrimination and sexual harassment.
- C. CESAR RITZ and the WSU faculty director immediately will remove any program participant from any situation construed by the student as involving sexual harassment.
- D. CESAR RITZ will immediately report any incidents deemed to be in violation of these policies to the WSU faculty member, who in turn will report to the WSU Education Abroad Office.

## **XII. INSURANCE**

- A. CESAR RITZ will maintain liability insurance coverage during the term of this Agreement with \$1,000,000 as the minimum underlying limit of liability (combined for both bodily injury and property).

- B. CESAR RITZ agrees to provide WSU with a certificate of insurance clearly indicating the company providing such coverage by January 1 of each calendar year. CESAR RITZ further agrees to add WSU as an additional insured party under its liability insurance coverage. Such coverage shall be primary and non-contributory. CESAR RITZ shall notify WSU immediately if for any reason the full amount of this insurance is not in effect at any relevant time.

### **XIII. RECORDS MAINTENANCE**

The parties to this AGREEMENT shall each maintain books, records, documents, and other evidence that sufficiently and properly reflects all performances of the services described herein. These records shall be subject to inspection, review, or audit by personnel of both parties, other personnel duly authorized by either party, the Washington State Office of the State Auditor, and federal officials so authorized by law. Access to all WSU student records is subject to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) procedures. Requests related to access of any WSU student records must be made in writing to the WSU Registrar's office. All books, records, documents, and other material relevant to this AGREEMENT will be retained for six (6) years after expiration of this AGREEMENT and the Washington State Office of the State Auditor, federal auditors, and any persons duly authorized by the parties shall have full access and the right to examine any of this material during this period.

Records and other documents, in any medium, furnished by one party to this AGREEMENT to the other party will remain the property of the furnishing party, unless otherwise agreed. The receiving party will not disclose or make available this material to any third parties without first giving notice to the furnishing party and giving it a reasonable opportunity to respond. Each party will utilize reasonable security procedures and protections to assure that record and documents provided by the other party are not erroneously disclosed to third parties.

### **XIV. RIGHTS IN DATA**

WSU and CESAR RITZ agree that any pamphlets and advertisements designed to promote this program shall be reviewed by both parties prior to publishing.

Any data compiled by WSU that originates for this AGREEMENT shall be "works for hire" as defined by the U.S. Copyright Act of 1976 and shall be owned by WSU. Data shall include, but not be limited to, reports, documents, pamphlets, advertisements, books, magazines, surveys, studies, computer programs, films, tapes, and/or sound reproductions. Ownership includes the right to copyright, patent, register, and the ability to transfer these rights.

### **XV. AGREEMENT ALTERATIONS AND AMENDMENTS**

This AGREEMENT may be amended by mutual AGREEMENT of the parties. Such amendments shall not be binding unless they are in writing and signed by personnel authorized to bind each of the parties. Amendments to this

AGREEMENT will be used to detail financial responsibilities of each party on a semester basis.

#### **XVI. TERMINATION**

Either party to this AGREEMENT can terminate it in writing by July 15 for the academic year beginning in October of the following calendar year. If this AGREEMENT is so terminated, the parties shall be liable for only for performance rendered or costs incurred in accordance with the terms of the AGREEMENT prior to the effective date of termination. Neither party to this AGREEMENT shall jointly acquire, hold or dispose of any property used in this undertaking. Unless the parties agree in writing otherwise, all property shall belong to the party that acquires it.

#### **XVII. TERMINATION FOR CAUSE**

If for any cause, either party does not fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this AGREEMENT, or if either party violates any of these terms and conditions, the aggrieved party will give the other party written notice of such failure or violation. The responsible party will be given the opportunity to correct the violation or failure within fifteen (15) working days. If failure or violation is not corrected, this AGREEMENT may be terminated immediately by written notice of the aggrieved party to the other. Should this occur, the disposition of any property shall be as provided above in the section entitled Termination.

#### **XIII. DISPUTES**

In an event that a dispute arises under this AGREEMENT, the parties shall first try to resolve it themselves. If those efforts are unsuccessful, a Dispute Panel shall decide the matter in the following manner. Each party to this AGREEMENT shall appoint one member to the Dispute Panel. The members so appointed shall jointly appoint an additional member to the Dispute Panel. The Dispute Panel shall determine their own process to resolve the dispute and shall review the facts, AGREEMENT terms, and applicable statutes and rules to make a determination of the dispute. The determination of the dispute shall be final and binding on the parties. Either party can enforce the decision of the Dispute Panel in a Washington State court if the party believes this is necessary. Under no circumstances shall parole evidence be used to dispute the terms of this AGREEMENT. This is the whole AGREEMENT between the parties.

#### **XIX. ASSIGNMENT**

The work to be provided under this AGREEMENT, and any claim arising hereunder, is not assignable or delegable by either party in whole or in part, without the express prior written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. Neither WSU nor CESAR RITZ may assign this AGREEMENT without the prior written consent of the other.

**XX. WAIVER**

A failure by either party to exercise its rights under this AGREEMENT shall not preclude that party from subsequent exercise of such rights and shall not constitute a waiver of any other rights under this AGREEMENT unless stated to be such in a writing signed by an authorized representative of the party and attached to the original AGREEMENT and incorporated by reference.

**XXI. SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this AGREEMENT or any provision of any document incorporated by reference shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this AGREEMENT so long as they can be given effect without the invalid provision, if such remainder conforms to the requirements of applicable law and the fundamental purpose of the AGREEMENT. To this extent, the provisions of this AGREEMENT are declared to be severable.

**XXII. ALL WRITINGS CONTAINED HEREIN**

This AGREEMENT contains all the terms and conditions agreed upon by the parties. No other understandings, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this AGREEMENT shall be deemed to exist or to bind any of the parties hereto.

**XIII. INDEMNIFICATION**


Each party to this AGREEMENT shall be responsible for the acts and/or omissions of itself, its officers, employees, and agents. The officers, employees and agents of each party who are engaged in the performance of this AGREEMENT shall continue to be the officers, employees or agents of that party and shall not be considered for any purpose to be officer, employees or agents of the other party.

**XIV. AGREEMENT MANAGMENT**

The AGREEMENT MANAGER for each of the parties shall be responsible for the daily operation of this AGREEMENT. These AGREEMENT MANAGERS also shall be the contact people for all communications and billings regarding the performance of this AGREEMENT. All notices required to be served upon either party shall be served by register or certified mail and a return receipt requested.

THE FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM SHALL BE the WSU College of Business (located in Pullman, Washington) and CESAR RITZ (located in Brig, Switzerland).





INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS PROGRAM AGREEMENT  
Between  
WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

U.C. CESAR RITZ AG IN SWITZERLAND

WHEREAS the parties have previously executed a certain International Business Program Agreement dated August 20, 2012 by WSU and CESAR RITZ (the "AGREEMENT"), which sets forth the general terms and conditions governing the collaborative study abroad program between WSU and CESAR RITZ.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to modify certain existing terms of the AGREEMENT, and supplement the AGREEMENT with additional terms and conditions governing the study abroad program, and to that end, execute this AMENDMENT 1 to the AGREEMENT.

NOW THEREFORE: Both Parties desire to continue the collaboration and amend the AGREEMENT for the Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 program, as follows:

Article IV. G hereby revised:

Each WSU student will pay \$5,040 US dollars for an 11-week term to CESAR RITZ 30-days prior to the beginning of the term. This amount includes: lunch and dinner Monday through Friday during the term; double room occupancy in standard accommodations; Cesar Ritz College (CRC) course materials; library use; wireless internet access; local tourism taxes; emergency assistance; college events; and other educational related expenses. Students are required to pay for the costs of their e-books for courses at CRC.

If there is a great fluctuation in exchange rates, each Party will agree to a new negotiated fee schedule to be authorized through an amendment to the AGREEMENT.

Article IV. I hereby revised:

WSU students are responsible for textbooks and IPADS; health and accident insurance; all ~~lunches~~ <sup>breakfast</sup> all meals on weekends and school holidays; any travel costs; personal expenses; and any damages to their accommodations.

Article IV. M hereby added:

WSU College of Business will pay to Cesar Ritz \$14,800 for the spring 2023 semester. This amount will cover: Faculty lodging in an apartment. This amount will cover the following: monthly rent, utilities, and maintenance reserve for spring 2023 term.

If there is a great fluctuation in exchange rates, each Party will agree to a new negotiated fee schedule to be authorized through an amendment to the AGREEMENT.


