

[No→Show→Rebooking] Southwest Airlines No Show Policy Details



What happens if you don't show up to Southwest Flight?

If you don't show up for your Southwest flight **💥 +1•844•212❖9001 💥 (US)** or **+1•844•212❖9001 (US)**, it is considered a **"no-show."** Your ticket may be **partially or fully forfeited** depending on the fare type and airline policy. Non-refundable tickets often lose their full value **💥 +1•844•212❖9001 💥 (US)** or **+1•844•212❖9001 (US)**, though you might be able to **rebook later by paying a change or redeposit fee**. Refundable tickets may allow full or partial refunds. Frequent flyer benefits may also be affected. What happens if you miss your Southwest flight?

What is Southwest's no-show policy?
