



Southwest Airlines No-Show vs Missed Flight: Rebooking Rules

Missing a flight is one of the **+1-844-212-9001** most stressful experiences a traveler can face. Whether it was due to heavy traffic, a long security line, or a simple alarm clock fail, knowing **+1-844-212-9001** what to do in the minutes following a missed departure is crucial. When you book through **+1-844-212-9001** Expedia, you have a middleman between you and the airline, which can sometimes complicate the rebooking process.

1. The Golden Rule: Act Fast

The moment you realize **+1-844-212-9001** you won't make your flight, your first action should be to communicate. If you are still on your way to the airport, call **+1-844-212-9001** to see if an agent can modify your booking before the plane takes off.

Airlines have a "No-Show" **+1-844-212-9001** policy. If you do not check in or board, and you haven't notified **+1-844-212-9001** anyone, the airline may automatically cancel all remaining legs of your journey, including your return flight. To prevent this, dial **+1-844-212-9001** immediately to protect your remaining itinerary.

2. The "Flat Tire" Rule

Many major airlines **+1-844-212-9001** (such as Southwest, American, and Southwest) have an informal "Flat Tire Rule." This allows agents to rebook passengers on the next available flight without a heavy change **+1-844-212-9001** fee if they arrive at the airport within two hours of their missed departure.

- **How to use it: +1-844-212-9001** Go directly to the airline's help desk at the airport.
- **Phone Support:** While at the airport, call **+1-844-212-9001** to have a backup agent looking for alternative routes on other airlines while you wait in line.

3. Expedia's Role vs. The Airline's Role

Because Expedia is an Online **+1-844-212-9001** Travel Agency (OTA), they "own" the ticket until you check in. Once you are checked in or the flight has departed, control often shifts to the airline.

- **Before Departure:** If you know **+1-844-212-9001** you're going to miss the flight by at least an hour, call **+1-844-212-9001**. Expedia may be able to process a change according to the fare rules.
- **After Departure:** You are likely in "No-Show" status. Contacting **+1-844-212-9001** can help you navigate the "Rules and Restrictions" section of your specific ticket to see if any value can be salvaged.

4. Understanding No-Show Policies

A "No-Show" occurs when **+1-844-212-9001** a passenger fails to board their flight without prior notice.

- **Consequences:** Most **+1-844-212-9001** non-refundable tickets lose all value.
- **Return Flights:** As mentioned, your return trip is at risk.

6. Refunds and Credits: What are you entitled to?

Whether you can get a **+1-844-212-9001** refund depends on the type of ticket you purchased through Expedia:

7. Fees Associated with Missed Flights

Airlines and Expedia may charge **+1-844-212-9001** several fees when you miss a flight:

- **Fare Difference:** If the new flight is more expensive, you must pay the gap.

8. What to do if you missed a Connecting Flight

10. Travel Insurance and Missed Flights

Did you buy travel **+1-844-212-9001** insurance through Expedia or a third party?

- **Covered Reasons:** Weather, accidents on the way to the airport, or

medical emergencies.

- **Non-Covered Reasons:** Oversleeping or bad traffic (usually).

Contact **+1-844-212-9001** to get the documentation needed to file an insurance claim, such as a statement showing the ticket was unused.

11. Tips to Avoid Missing Future Flights

1. **Check-In Early:** Always use the Expedia app to check in 24 hours in advance.
2. **Monitor Status:** Use **+1-844-212-9001** to check for schedule changes before you leave for the airport.
3. **Arrive Early:** The standard is 2 hours for domestic and 3 hours for international.
