There is also the option for single-player use. This can create high thinking due to the fact that the app will adjust to the user's ability level, yet still remain challenging for the student.

Strengths: This app track student performance so they can enhance their skills throughout their use. It is a great tool for utilizing student's desire for engaging activities while also being able to trust that the games are age appropriate. It is easy to use for any teacher, parent or student.

Weaknesses: It does not explicitly list that there are any other languages that it serves other than English. I would also caution the use of this as a primary lesson. This is more of a supplemental tool for students.
