Features: Customization of word recognition, font size and colors displayed. There are some images available for certain books (depends on the level of the reader).

Strengths: Users who are blind may read with braille, using a device attached to the app directly via bluetooth, you may adjust the speed at which the audio reads aloud, and there are options to set bookmarks.

Weaknesses: Unfortunately there are not many options to provide users with different languages.
