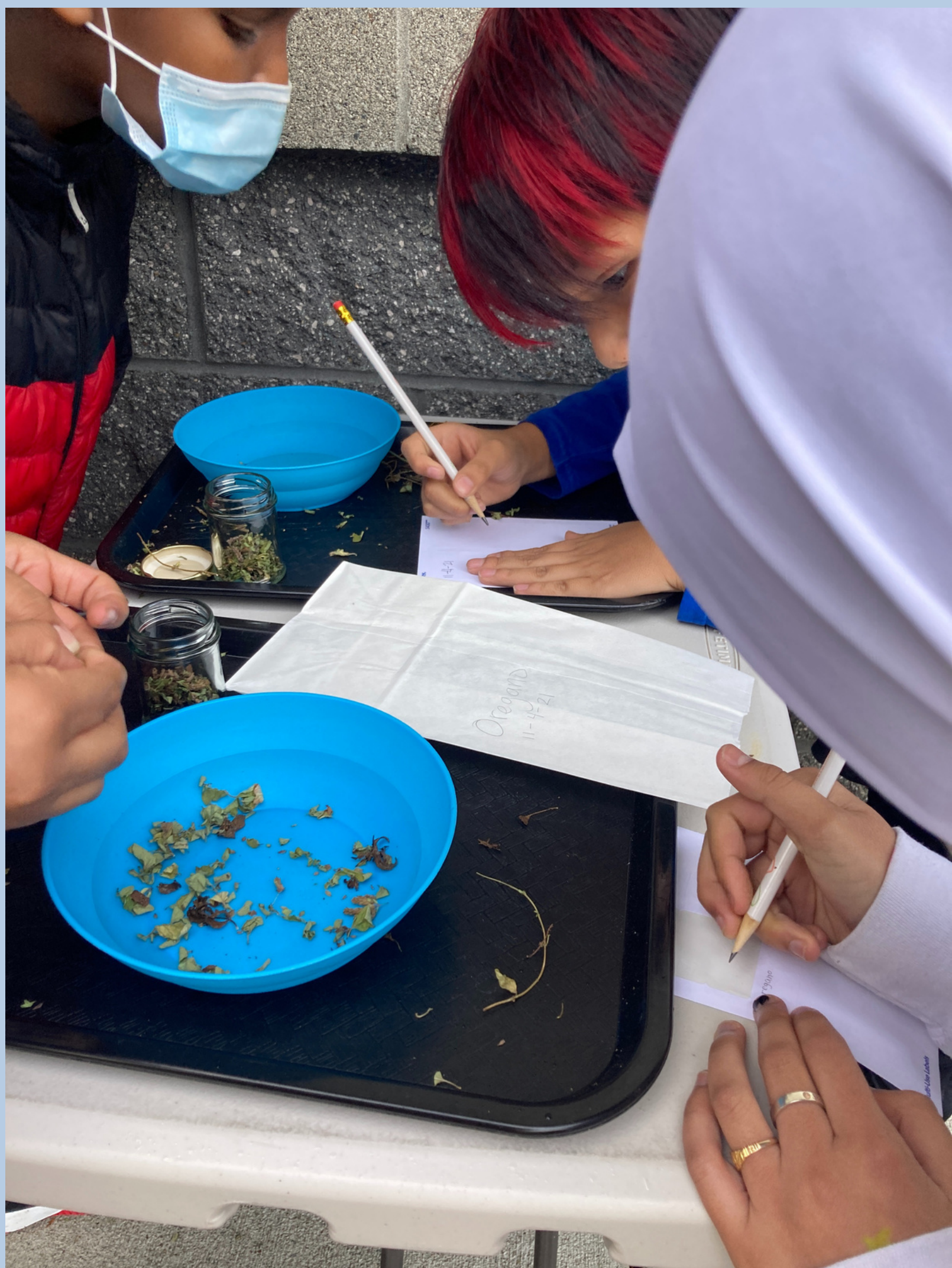



















This is what you planted!





Caring for your seedlings

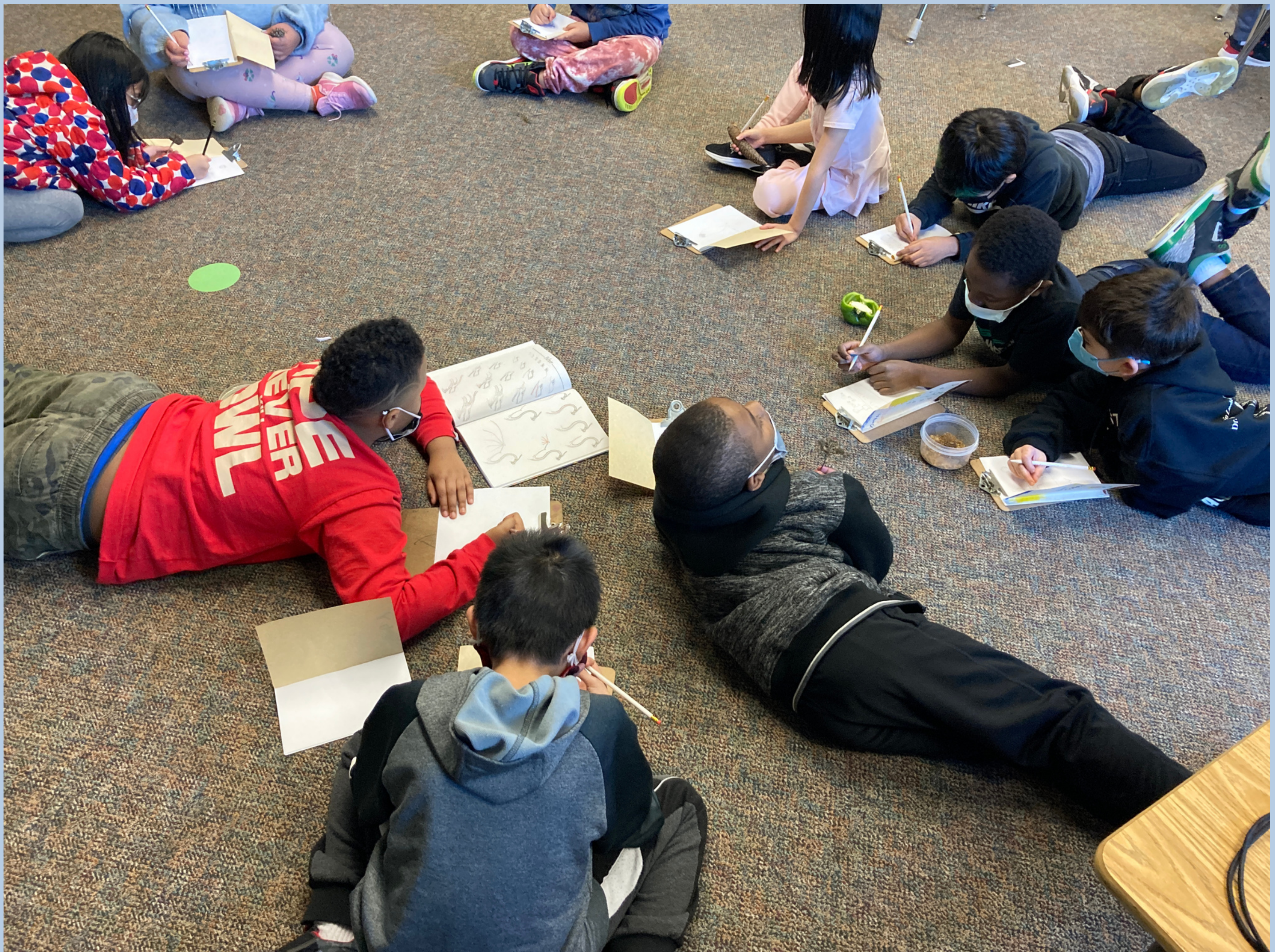


Place the seed trays in the sunniest location possible.
Keep the plastic dome over the baby seeds until true leaves appear.
Water seeds every day using the spray bottle. The soil should look moist at all times but not be soaking wet.
Before the weekend give seedlings an extra watering.
Once the plant's true leaves appear remove the dome.
Encourage students to visit the plants and talk nicely to them. Plants love that!
Once plants are the optimal size and it warms up we'll be transplanting them into the garden. The timing for this is up to nature and having good luck with our seeds.





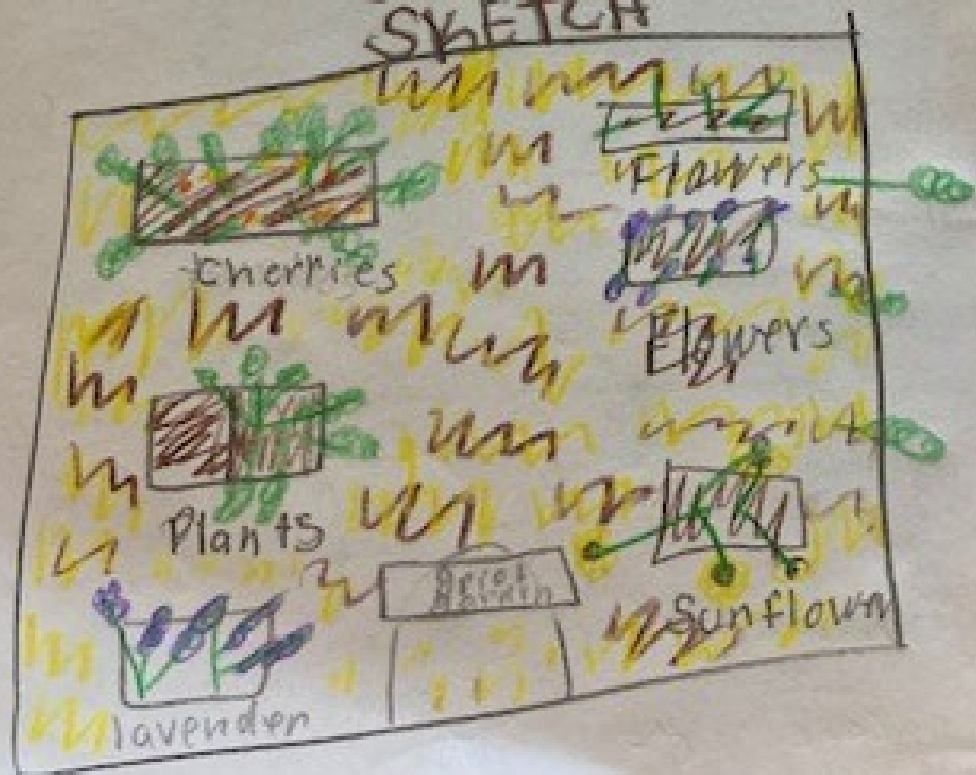

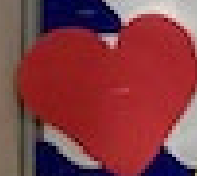
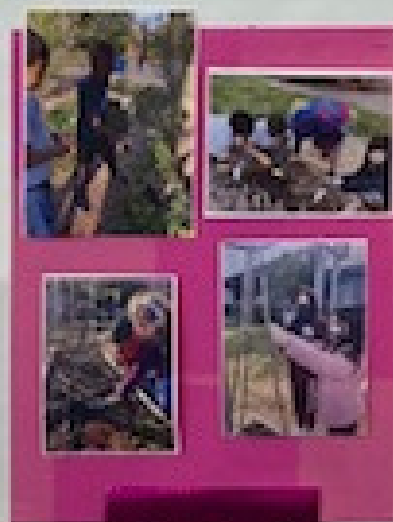
Hi to Ms. Candis
