- First cohort of 60 WSU medical students began classes on Monday

News from College of Pharmacy

- Two departments: 25 faculty members in Pharmaceutical Sciences; 30 in Pharmacotherapy
- Pharmacy begins its 3rd year of PharmD education in Yakima this Fall
- Total enrollment of ~625 PharmD students
- PharmSci graduate program currently enrolls 28 students (27 PhD, 1 MS)
- COP research expenditures, July 2016-June 2017:
 - \$6,201,714
 - \$969,408 (15.6%) is from USTUR
