Who Can Apply?

- You must be **security clearance eligible**
- A **GPA of 3.2** or higher is required
- **WSU undergraduates**, preferably with at least two years before graduation
- CySER is designed as a two year program. Students who have **previously** participated in one year of CySER should apply.

Requirements

- Pursue one of the CySER **certificates**
- Participation in WSU's cybersecurity student **club**, [Cyber Security Group](#)
- Participation in at least one cybersecurity **competition** per academic year
- Attend CySER **seminars** and summer **workshop**
- Participate in a mentored **research** project
