TECHNICAL SERGEANT TIMOTHY B. TENNY

TSgt Timothy Tenny is a ROTC Training Instructor at AFROTC Detachment 905, Washington State University, Pullman, Washington. He directly oversees the cadet life-cycle while supporting 6 cadre and 101 cadets. He serves as the detachment Key Enlisted Leader and as the primary enlisted advisor to the Detachment Commander and cadre on a wide range of topics, and assists officer instructors in educating cadets on AFROTC curriculum.

TSgt Tenny entered into active duty Air Force in June of 2007 after completing High School. He completed F-16 Integrated Avionics technical training in March 2008, and went on to serve in a variety of aircraft maintenance positions. He was first stationed at Elmendorf AFB in Anchorage, Alaska where he maintained the avionics components of a squadron of F-22 Raptors in the 90th AMU from March 2008 to April 2011. He and his wife were then transferred to Kirtland AFB in Albuquerque, New Mexico from April 2011 to December 2013 to maintain the avionics systems of the CV-22 Osprey with the 71st AMU. He and his wife were then transferred to RAF Mildenhall in Mildenhall, United Kingdom from January 2014 to January 2018. He began his assignment at RAF Mildenhall as a Quality Assurance inspector with the 352 Special Operations Aircraft Maintenance Group until



January 2016 when he was transferred back to the flightline as a CV-22 Osprey Avionics Technician with the 352nd AMU. After completing their overseas tour, they were then assigned to the 20th AMU at Cannon AFB in Clovis, New Mexico from January 2018 to November 2023 as an Avionics technician and Avionics NCOIC. Prior to his current position, he was the CV-22 Specialist Section Chief for the 20th AMU at Cannon AFB in Clovis New Mexico.

During TSgt Tenny's enlistment he has deployed multiple times. Most notable are his deployment to Iraq in support of Operation Inherent Resolve in 2018 and two deployments to Afghanistan in 2019 and 2020 in support of Operation Resolute Support and Operation Freedom Sentinel during which he supported the retrograde from Afghanistan.
