We envision the fellowship program laying a foundation that facilitates long-term international research collaborations between students and their affiliated academic advisors with international mentors. We believe that the graduate students supported by this program will eventually assume leadership positions in a wide variety of organizations, and across an array of disciplines related to food security.
