## Science Pub Speaker & Topics



### Recognition of Cryptic Species

Dr. James B. (Ding) Johnson (Ph.D. Entomology, University of California, Berkeley) is an emeritus Professor of Entomology and Department Head in the Department of Plant, Soil, and Entomological Sciences at the University of Idaho. He has conducted externally funded research on insect biology and systematics, emphasizing green lacewing of the genus *Chrysoperla*, biological control of insect pests, rangeland entomology, and the impacts of ants on radioactive waste for 34 years.

*Chrysoperla carnea* (Stephens) was described from London, England in 1837. In the last 179 years, the name has appeared in numerous systematic, biological, ecological, and agricultural publications. Dr. Johnson will be speaking about his research on this "song species" of insect and additional entomological information.
